Corona prevention in practice

Special times require special measures. We have increased the frequency of disinfection measures in the plant to protect employees and thus maintain security of supply.

We have external service providers who disinfect all doorknobs, surfaces and hand rails which employees frequently come in contact with, on a daily basis. We also continue to disinfect all keyboards and control units on the machines after every shift.

In doing so we maintain a high level of hygiene and minimize a risk of contamination.

The forklifts and manual forklifts in use are also completely disinfected at the start of every shift.

In addition, once a week, the production halls are completely disinfected by an external company with a spray. An ozone purification device is currently being tested to purify the air in the halls and initial tests are very promising.


Huhtamaki now produces disinfectant

We first invested in a solvent recovery unit in 1983 and since then have continually reinvested and expanded our solvent recovery capacity. As you are aware, a key by-product of industrial printing is lost solvents into the atmosphere. A solvent recovery unit essentially captures these lost solvents by feeding it through an active carbon filter and distilling it back into liquid alcohol. This allows us to reduce our negative impact on the environment and enables us to re-use the solvents in our production process.

As a company we are also aware of our social responsibility to do whatever we can to get through the Corona virus pandemic. After learning of a shortage of disinfectants in the market one of our employees came up with the idea of slightly modifying the alcohol we distill from our solvent recovery unit and to produce industrial disinfectant. We have now done this and have started donating this to local rest homes, hospitals and pharmacies.

Donating face masks to medical / health institutions

In our last edition we talked about how we could secure enough face masks to secure the hygiene measures. In fact we were even able to gift more than 3.500 masks to medical- and health institution. "Working for a company that helps other people in days like these makes me very proud" says Anja Mayr, member of the team that is coordinating all the "Huhtamaki helps" actions.



Given how the situation is changing on a daily basis, we are doing our best to ensure we are there for you and we will keep you updated on how we are getting through this crisis.
